Dr. YOSHIDA Junichi is Director of Chemicals and Fuels Section, Carbon Recycling Unit, Circular Economy Department at NEDO (New Energy and Industrial Technology Development Organization), which is Japan's largest technology projects management organization affiliated with METI (Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry). He oversees NEDO-funded research, development and demonstration projects for carbon conversion and utilization, also known as carbon recycling, including the Carbon Recycling RD&D Base project at Osaki Kamijima.
